### School Rules

- Treat others in the school with kindness and courtesy. Rude and unmannerly behaviour e.g. spitting, name-calling, or intimidation of others and the use of bad language and vulgarity of any kind is strictly forbidden.
- Bullying in any form is totally unacceptable. Aggressive threatening violent or any other anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated.
- Pupils must arrive in time for school (for 9.20 a.m. each morning) and obey the school bell promptly at all breaks. Pupils should be collected promptly at 3 p.m. and vacate the premises in order to comply with insurance regulations.
- No student has permission to leave the school during the day. Pupils must ask the teacher to retrieve the ball if it goes over the wall etc. No climbing allowed. Play safely on the ground always.
- In accordance with our Healthy Eating Policy, fizzy drinks, junk food and chewing gum are not allowed in school. For safety reasons 'Tippex' and other solvent based substances are not allowed either.
- No pupil has permission to bring a mobile phone to school. If you as a parent/guardian deem it as an absolute necessity for your child to have a phone due to after school commitments the following procedures need to be followed.
  - 1) A letter outlining the reasons your child requires a phone to be brought to school is to be forwarded to the Principal.
  - 2) The phone must then be handed into the office that morning and may be collected by the child at 3 p.m.

If any child is found to be in breach of this policy the phone will be confiscated and will only be returned to the parent/guardian.
- Pupils should respect all school property and the private property of others and treat all books and equipment with care. This rule will particularly extend to misuse or abuse of computer equipment. Internet access must be strictly under teacher supervision only.
- Intentional disruption of class will not be tolerated. Homework must be neatly done as allocated – Failure to do so must be accompanied by a note from parents. Parents should sign diaries at the weekend in senior classes.
- Our school uniform is our sense of identity and belonging in The Rower N.S. Please wear it with pride every day. School tracksuits to be worn on P.E. days. Indoor shoes must be worn in class. Helmets must be worn when hurling.
